This panel will explore the involvement as Amicus Curiae and identify some of the factors taken into consideration by NRRRA when deciding on whether to become involved. A few cases where NRRRA chose to become involved will be reviewed and analyzed. The panel will then explore the question of whether NRRRA's resources and efforts would be more effectively deployed by filing a class action/request for injunctive relief against California DOI, in a matter similar to NRRRA v. Brown, and the basis for such a consideration.

The goal of this session is to discuss with NRRRA's membership two approaches that can be used in taking action on their behalf and gaining its feedback concerning possible action in a matter under consideration.
